** Quantitative target for 2030 is not specified in the SDG indicator framework; targets are estimated.

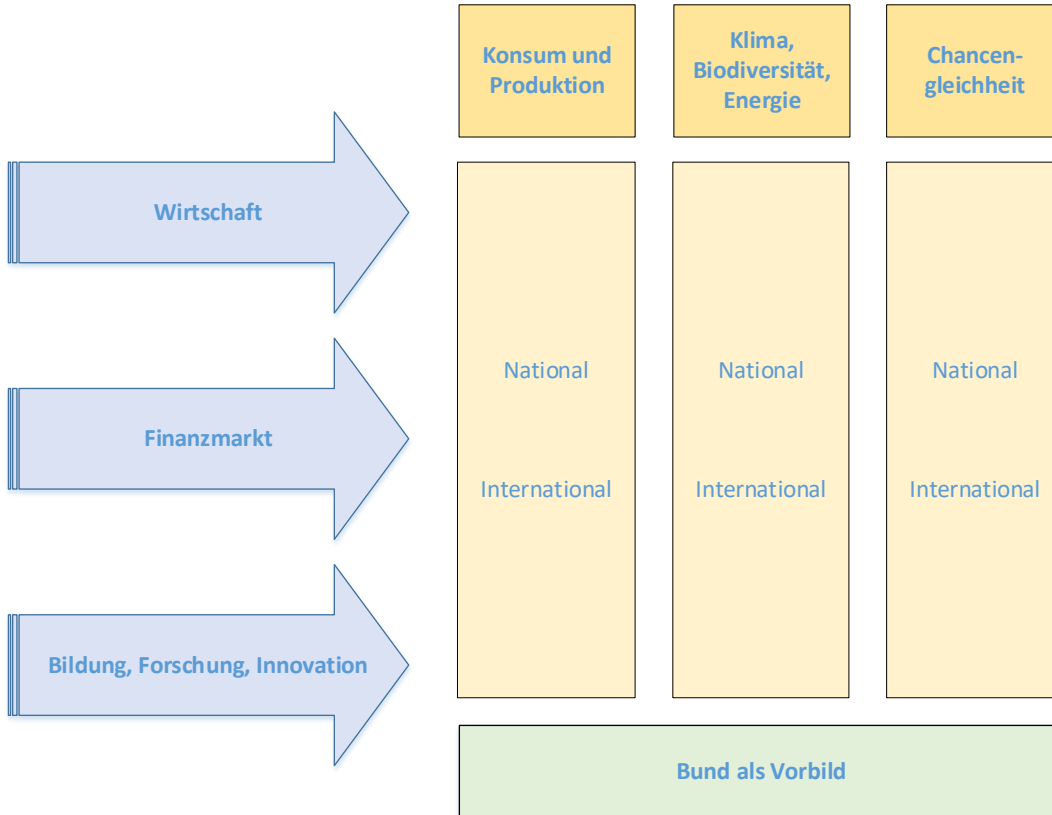
** Assessment is based on indicators outside the SDG indicator framework; inequality in income is based on data from household surveys.

At the global level, table 1-1 and several other assessments (see box 1-4), as well as the 2019 Global Environment Outlook (GEO-6) assessment, the 2018 and 2019 Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) reports, the 2019 Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES) report and the latest report of the Committee for the Review of the Implementation of the Convention to Combat Desertification (CRIC), paint a similar picture that allow for broad conclusions.¹⁶

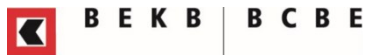

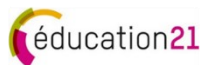

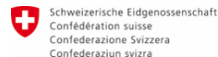
